

EVENT INFORMATION

- Pageants are open to California residents only. Twirl status determines pageant level.
 - **BASIC SKILLS COMPETITION** is open to Novice contestants only. Contest is 20% Modeling, 40% Basic Strut and 40% Twirl. You may enter both Basic Skills and Beginner Pageant.
- **CALIFORNIA MISS MAJORETTE:** First, second & third place advanced "Royalty" winners in the Tiny Tot, Juvenile, PreTeen, Junior and Teenage divisions are eligible to enter respective Official Miss Majorette of America Pageants. Only first place Beginner and Intermediate Pageant winners are eligible to enter Official Beginner and Intermediate Pageants at Notre Dame University, July, 2019.
- Pageant Modeling: Attire per NBTA rules.

Awards

Modeling: Modeling is in "Circle T" pattern with seated interview. (No interview for Basic Skills.) Modeling will start with the letter "M". Strut and Twirl will be moved down by 1/3 of the division.

GUIDELINES

Novice Division: A twirler who has not won five first place awards in Novice Twirl or a first place in a higher division.

Beginner Division: A twirler who has not won five first place awards in Beginner Twirl or a first place in a higher division.

Intermediate Division: A twirler who has not won eight first place awards in Intermediate Twirl or a first place in a higher division. Miss College Majorette: Per NBTA rules, "shall compete in twirling contest by using a 2:20 – 2:30 show routine. The first half with one baton. The second half of routine may, if desired, incorporate other twirling media, except fire, to standard music. Entrants are those who are furthering her education by attending a College, University of other Institutions of higher learning."

Judging:

20% Modeling, 40% Strutting, 40% Twirling. Ties will be broken by twirling score. Trophies through 3rd place, 4th & 5th medals in pageant divisions. Medals through 3rd place in each pageant event. Open events: 1St Place trophy, 2nd through 5th place medals Awards:

Per NBTA rules, medals only for Novice events
